Environment and Permitting

Close Generate 2015 by joining us for a one-day long workshop aimed at providing the most recent updates on the initiatives and directions pertaining to the regulatory framework that governs the Clean Energy industry. In keeping with the theme of this year's conference (Think Bigger), regulators, proponents and practitioners will gather to share the results of several years of monitoring of clean energy projects. Through this sharing of information we will focus the discussion on the improvement of monitoring guidelines and the role for the clean energy industry in regional monitoring and the management of cumulative effects.

The workshop will provide an opportunity to bring government, proponents, practitioners and academics together in an engaging format to learn and share with one another. The workshop will include select presentations, participatory exercises, and panel discussions.

SHORT COURSE #2 //

Climate Leadership and Clean Electricity:

Understanding Opportunities for the Clean Energy Sector and How to Inform the Provinces Process

The Provincial Government is working on the next set of policies for its climate leadership plan. Work by Clean Energy Canada in partnership with Navius Research shows that climate leadership in British Columbia could mean more than doubling B.C.'s clean electricity sector over the next 35 years. Hydro, wind, solar, biomass and geothermal are all needed to help reduce pollution from heating B.C.'s homes, powering its industries and driving its vehicles. During this session Michael Wolinetz from Navius Research Inc. and Jeremy Moorhouse from Clean Energy Canada will describe the role of renewable electricity in achieving British Columbia's climate targets and opportunities for the industry to inform the leadership plan. consultants, regulators, developers, and academics.

Operations Workshop

CEBC will again be offering a one day Operations Workshop.
